SafeRoad acquires 80 % of the Polish company Kabex Sp.z o.o.

Kabex offers products and services in the fields of road marking, road signs, road and bridge railings and barriers and road maintenance. The company is located in Gdansk and occupies a favourable strategic position in a strongly growing regional market for traffic goods.

As part of its growth strategy for Central and Eastern Europe, SafeRoad, through its subsidiary SafeRoad Polska, has acquired 80% of the shares of the Polish company Kabex. The remaining 20% are retained by senior employees of the company. Kabex has 19 employees and had a turnover of about NOK 22 million in 2007.

SafeRoad intends to become the leading supplier of road safety solutions in Europe. By means of this acquisition, SafeRoad Polska will gain access to new geographical market sectors and further strengthen its position as a leading total supplier of road safety solutions in Poland.

The agreement between Saferoad AS and Kabex Sp.z o.o. was entered into in March 2008.
